ABOUT ANGEL MOUNDS

Angel Mounds State Historic Site is one of the best-preserved, pre-contact Native American sites in North America. Built between A.D. 1000 and 1450, the town was occupied by more than 1,000 people part of the Mississippian culture. The society built 11 earthen mounds as platforms to elevate important buildings.

The site was abandoned before European explorers came to North America. Possible explanations for abandonment are depletion of natural resources, climatic changes, or the collapse of the chiefdom.

More than 600 acres comprise Angel Mounds State Historic Site, which includes an interpretive center, recreations of Mississippian buildings, and a working reconstruction of the 1939 WPA archaeology laboratory.

THE TRAIL ROUTE

This 5K's grassy course runs around the mounds. The course is not stroller friendly.

WHILE YOU'RE THERE

Visit the interactive Visitors Center - Learn about the history and archaeology of the site, touch casts made from real Native American artifacts, and more.

Pack a lunch - there are picnic tables and grills throughout the site where you can enjoy lunch with your coworkers and families.

Explore - Hike and explore the mounds that make this site so famous, or even take a longer walk on hiking trails that run around the property.
