MORE ABOUT THE PARK

Clifty Falls State Park is made up of 1,519 acres and was established in 1920 in Madison, IN.

The Park also features some of the oldest bedrock exposures in Indiana, with 425-million-year-old shale and limestone rocks.

The trails total 12 miles of moderate to rugged paths, and the Park includes four major waterfalls. One trail features a 600-foot tunnel, a remnant of a railroad project of the 1850s.

THE TRAIL ROUTES

The Green Trail is a guided, moderate, one-mile trail hike. Participants will be able to hear a history of the park while taking in views of the park's waterfalls and rock formations.

The Railroad Hike is a three-mile fitness hike through some of the park's most rugged/difficult trails. This hike will take approximately two hours to complete. Strollers are not recommended on either hike. Hiking boots are encouraged.

WHILE YOU'RE THERE

Pack a lunch - there are picnic tables and grills throughout the Park where you can enjoy lunch with your coworkers and families.

Stay overnight - check out the Clifty Inn as a place to stay for a quick getaway. The Inn has an indoor swimming pool, and the Inn's restaurant is open to the public!

Play tennis - Clifty Falls State Park has tennis courts across from Clifty Inn.
